JM EAGLE ANNOUNCES \$10,000 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

JM Eagle will award \$10,000 to the student who submits the most compelling paper about the advantages of plastic pipe in a modern infrastructure.

Open to junior- and senior-year and graduate students of civil engineering and related majors, the scholarship represents JM Eagle's commitment to supporting the next generation of engineers. It began Nov. 1, and the deadline for submission is Feb. 17, 2012.

"At JM Eagle, we believe in creating safe and sustainable foundations in which citizens of the future will prosper and thrive," says JM Eagle President and CEO Walter Wang. "That means not only building infrastructures that deliver safe and clean water, but

also supporting education of our youth so they in turn help make the world a better place."

The \$10,000 scholarship contest asks students to form a 2,500- to 5,000-word argument describing plastic pipe's beneficial role over other materials in building and replacing municipalities' waterworks systems. Entries will be judged on vision, understanding of issues, originality and emphasis on material solutions.
