JM EAGLE PRODUCTS IN COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA CODES

NSF International has informed JM Eagle that its potable water products are in compliance with California's Health & Safety Code Section 116875, commonly known as AB1953.

Deemed compliant were JM Eagle's PVC pipe, PEX tubing, PE pipe and PE molded fittings under NSF Standard 61 Annex G for all potable water applications.

"This question of whether we are in compliance with AB1953 has been asked of JM Eagle many times, and more so lately," says Mai Huynh, JM Eagle quality assurance manager. "We are pleased to report that the answer is a definitive 'yes,' and that the compliance footnote will be added to the official listings for the abovementioned products."

The footnote reads:

[G] Product also certified to NSF/ANSI Standard 61, Annex G (weighted average lead content of <=0.25 percent) and is in compliance with California's Health & Safety Code Section 116875 (commonly known as AB1953).

"JM Eagle is proud to be in compliance with all applicable codes," says Huynh. "Meeting and exceeding all quality standards is our way of doing business."
